Welcome to UT Health San Antonio! We are so happy to have you join our faculty. UT Health SA is made up of the Dental School, Medical School, School of Health Professions, School of Nursing, and the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences. The university is one of four medical schools in the University of Texas System. The school has eight campuses spanning 250 acres in total.

UT Health SA serves San Antonio as well as Central and South Texas. Its campuses extend into Laredo and the Lower Rio Grande Valley. More than 3,000 students a year train in the affiliated hospitals, clinics and other health care facilities. UT Health is also home to the Cancer Therapy and Research Center, which is designated a National Cancer Institute and is affiliated with MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston.

As for a little history, the first medical school class was admitted in 1966 and in 1969 the dental school was created. The School of nursing began a year later. In 1972, the school of allied health sciences and graduate school were created and the facility was officially designated the University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio. In 1998, the state legislature authorized the creation of our branch in the Lower Rio Grande Valley – The Regional Academic Health Center and in 2002, the RAHC opened its doors to medical students and residents. In 2007, the Cancer Therapy and Research Center (CTRC) was acquired by the health science center. Most recently in 2017, the health science center has changed its name to UT Health San Antonio.

San Antonio is a wonderful city, full of culture and rich with history. We hope you enjoy all the city has to offer.
