

Fifth Pathway Checklist

Per the ACGME Institutional Requirements, a Fifth Pathway program is an **academic year of supervised clinical education provided by an LCME-accredited medical School**. This option is not one that is universally available, and it is the program's responsibility to obtain written verification that applicants meet all requirements as listed below, prior to enrollment in the GME program.

1. Applicant has completed, in an accredited college or university in the United States, undergraduate premedical education of the quality acceptable for matriculation in an accredited United States medical school;		
2. Applicant has studied at a medical school outside the U.S. and Canada but listed in the World Health Organization Directory of Medical Schools		
3. Applicant has completed all of the formal requirements of the foreign medical school except internship and/or social service		
4. Applicant has attained a score satisfactory to the sponsoring medical school on a screening examination;		
5. Applicant has passed either the Foreign Medical Graduate Examination in the Medical Sciences, Parts I and II of the examination of the National Board of Medical Examiners, or Steps 1 and 2 of the United States Medical Licensing Examination (USMLE).
