<b>Resident Applicant Information</b>			
Policy	<p>The NRMP requires that applicants for residency positions through the NRMP who are invited to interview must be given complete and accurate information regarding the policies and procedures governing their training programs. This must include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• a sample contract</li> <li>• all institutional policies regarding eligibility for appointment to a residency program.</li> </ul> <p>It is the policy of the UTHSCSA GME Committee that, at a minimum, programs provide to applicants who are invited to interview for residency positions the information above, in either electronic or hard copy format, and to document that the information has been shared. The program director will be responsible for maintaining this documentation.</p> <p>If they wish, programs may share more information with the interviewees, including printed copies of the material listed above.</p>
