## **ASHBEL SMITH PROFESSOR (NON-ENDOWED PROFESSORSHIPS)**

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### **Policy**

The Health Science Center has Regental approval to use the honorary title, Ashbel Smith Professorship, in honor of the first Chair of the Board of Regents. The allotment of these non-endowed professorships at the Health Science Center is five.

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### **Criteria**

The general criteria for appointments to these professorships are:

1. Attainment of the rank of Professor with tenure at the Health Science Center.
2. Demonstration, as determined by faculty peers, of excellence in teaching and scholarship.
3. Earned distinction and recognition to the institution as a result of academic accomplishments.
4. Possession of personal characteristics that permit an appointee to serve as an example to students and faculty.

As a requirement of the Health Science Center, the following criteria will be used in addition to those listed above:

1. Dedicated and effective service at the Health Science Center.
  2. Contribution over a period of time to the material development of a department and/or the Health Science Center.
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### **Process**

Appointment to this title is made on the recommendation of the Chair with the approval of the appropriate Dean and the President. Upon approval an Ashbel Smith Professor will be appointed for a period of time not to exceed five (5) years.

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
