The Mays Cancer Center at UT Health San Antonio MD Anderson has a twelve-week research program for undergraduate students attending UTSA, St. Mary's University or University of the Incarnate Word. The goal of this program is to provide cancer research experiences for individuals from minority populations that are underrepresented in the sciences. At the end of the summer program, students will present their work at an award reception.
