

New ERMS- Grants Module

In April 2024, UT Health San Antonio's (UTHSA) Vice President for Research Office, began initial work for the new Grants module within the Enterprise Research Management System (ERMS).

The ERMS Grants module will effectively provide a modernized IT solution able to support our growing research infrastructure. The implementation of ERMS Grants will offer requested advancements, including streamlining workflows, processes, and the elimination of a separate manual certificate of proposal (COP). In addition, the module provides comprehensive pre-award and post-award management capabilities, improves transparency to faculty and staff throughout the institution. The new module enables faculty and staff to route and approve proposals, submit most federal applications to grants.gov and manage awards.

Current active awards will be transferred and available for investigators within the new ERMS Grants module when the module is launched, Spring 2025.

Investigators may continue to use Cayuse to submit federal applications to grants.gov through November 2025.
